## Pine Run Elementary 2023-2024 School Supply List

## Kindergarten

- Organizational Box - To hold small items like pencils and crayons. A small box is preferred over a soft, zippered bag
- One - Two-Pocket Folder (no flanges)
- Crayons - 16 pack (no larger) - Remove crayons from box and place in a Ziploc baggie labeled with your child's name
- Twelve - No. 2 pencils (Dixon or Princess only)
- 4 black, thick Expo markers and an old sock for erasing - place in a Ziploc baggie labeled with your child's name
- $\mathbf{4}$ glue sticks
- 1 thick yellow highlighter
- 1 pair of headphones stored in a Ziploc bag with your child's name clearly marked on the outside (for computer use). Earbuds are not the best for our Kindergarteners. Ones that have a band to connect the earpieces work best.
- Backpack
- Snack bag Or lunchbox
- 1 package of baby wipes
- 1 box of tissues
- Hand Sanitizer (last names A-M)
- Gallon size Ziploc bags (last names N-Z)


## $1^{\text {st }}$ Grade

- Plastic Folder - (1 green pocket folder)
- Crayons (2 boxes of 16-24 pack)
- Glue Sticks (4)
- Scissors - blunt (1)
- Expo Markers - black (8)
- Pencil Box/Case (big enough to hold all supplies in desk)
- Pencils \#2 (24) - sharpened please ©
- Pink erasers (large rectangular -2)
- One small personal pencil sharpener with lid
- A watercolor palette and brush
- Headphones (labeled)
- Whiteboard Eraser/Old Sock
- One box of tissues

- A personal pencil sharpener with cover to collect the shavings.
- 4 highlighters
- Bag of coins for math (4 quarters, 10 dimes, 10 nickels, 10 pennies)
