# Anything you want to volunteer for, we will be there to help as much as you need. You won't have to do it without support!

Event or Committee	Date	Description
Opening Family Social	September 20th	Coordinate gathering of hotdogs, snack bags and water bottles, etc. Help with set up and clean up.
Homeroom Parent Coordinator	Most work in September, email reminders the rest of the year	Hand out recruitment and information fliers for each classroom. Gather all emails of homeroom parents in case we need to reach out to the classrooms during the year. Much of this can be coordinated at home.
Fall & Spring Book Fairs	Fall: Oct 18 <sup>th</sup> to 25 <sup>th</sup> and Spring: May 26 <sup>th</sup> to 29th	Set up and take down of book fair. Organize volunteers needed. This is great because there isn't a lot of pre planning, just show up and do!
Ice Cream Social	October 18 <sup>th</sup>	This is the kick-off party to the fall book fair. We will need help with gathering supplies, set-up and clean up and organizing volunteer shifts.
Teacher Luncheon	December 20 <sup>th</sup>	Coordinate food donations to give our teachers a great appreciation lunch!
Holiday Shop	Friday, December 6 <sup>th</sup>	A fun event for students and family to start holiday shopping! We need help coordinating crafts for kids, vendors for adult shopping, food and the holiday shop for kids. A different person for each category would be great! This year we have had shoppers shopping clearance items to supply our kid holiday shop store. If this event is to continue, we will need future clearance shoppers.
Bingo Night	January 24 <sup>th</sup>	Table set up, prize coordination, pretzels, callers, etc. Help with all or a part of making this night happen.
March into Spring	Last week of February into March. Four weeks total	Starts in the fall to coordinate the programs offered, create and distribute class offerings, collect class requests, organize/call participate lists, support attendance and dismissal volunteers during the class weeks. Volunteers can start as early as October and can be apart of the many important aspects of this special program. Excel is used for class enrollment and organization. Email is a great tool as well.
Skate Night	February TBD	Coordinate the bake sale for the evening. Order pizzas, Costco pick up and work the bake sale table.

Teacher Appreciation Week	May/Spring – date TBD	Coordinate a special meal or treat during this week.
Under the Sea Night Out/ Dance	March 20 <sup>th</sup>	Decorate, gather refreshments, set up and clean up. Make a memorable night for our daughters!
Western Night/ Dance	March 27 <sup>th</sup>	Decorate, gather refreshments, set up and clean up. Make a memorable night for our sons!
Spring Fair	May 9 <sup>th</sup>	There are many pieces that come together to create an amazing family day. We need coordinators for: silent auctions, class baskets, book sale, inside and outside food, games, prizes, and more! Many volunteers are needed to plan and execute this favorite family event. Volunteers are also needed to help in one hour shifts the day of the fair.
End of Year Teacher Lunch	Last Day of School, Currently June 15 <sup>th</sup>	Coordinate a thank you lunch for the teachers.
Box Tops	All Year	Help cut and prep box tops. You can do this at home and it adds up! Last year we earned over \$1500!
Baker for Special Events	Various Times During the Year	We need baked (or store bought) goods donated for various events during the year.
Yearbook Committee	All Year, all grade levels	Take tons of pictures, upload them to the website and organize them into a book for us! We need all grade level volunteers!
Giant Card and Amazon Smiles	All Year	This is a passive fundraiser where we need to raise awareness and remind people to participate in
