OCTOBER

Asset #18: Youth Programs

Young person spends 3 or more hours per week in sports, clubs or organizations at school or in the community.

NOVEMBER

Asset #24: Positive Peer Influence

Young person best friends model responsible behavior.

DECEMBER

Asset #29: Honesty

Young person "tells the truth even when it is not easy".

JANUARY

Asset #27: Equality and Justice

Young person places high value on promoting equality and reducing hunger and poverty.

FEBRUARY

Asset #26: Caring

Young person cares about others. They place a high value on helping other people.

MARCH

Asset #17: Creative Activities

Young person spends 3 or more hours per week in lessons or practicing music, theater or the arts.

APRIL

Asset #25: Reading for Pleasure

Young person reads for pleasure most days of the week, either alone, with family members or with friends.

MAY

Asset #37: Personal Power

Young person feels he or she has control over "things that happen to me".
