



## Guidelines for Uploading Video Content to SchoolTube



**Overview:** SchoolTube will be the district video hosting site for the 2013-14 school year. SchoolTube is a video hosting web site for teachers to share their educational videos with students and other educators. There is a free registration procedure that takes teachers through an approval process to verify that they are an educator. Once accepted to the site, CBSD teachers can upload videos that go into a "holding" area. That video then awaits approval by the website's moderator before becoming available. Once approved, teachers can embed the video code directly into their Schoolwires teacher site.

Please read the guidelines below and adhere to them while using videos as an instructional tool in CBSD.

### Guidelines:

1. Educational and purposeful videos may be embedded into Schoolwires sites that are hosted on SchoolTube. Examples of videos that could be hosted on SchoolTube are: teacher created flipped lessons, documentaries, instructional videos you may have legally downloaded and are licensed to redistribute, and student-created video projects which the teacher may want to use for instruction or as exemplars. *Please do not use this as place to host a video of your class party or something that may be considered as non-educational.*
2. It is recommended that you embed videos into your Schoolwires teacher site however videos may also be viewed directly from the SchoolTube Channel.
3. If there is an educational need to post student-created videos to SchoolTube, students would submit their files to their teacher (via the Stu\_Drop\_Folder or via SkyDrive sharing). The teacher would then post the video to SchoolTube using the teacher's account.
