

# **Culture Path Policy for Non-Registered Friends and Family**

We are very happy to see friends and family at all the public events that are held throughout the tour. In this regard, certain policies are in place in consideration of the preparation of the tour arrangements and regulations that are mandated by insurance. These policies may be further expanded by the tour committee and the director of the ensemble.

# Concerts

We look forward to seeing all friends and families at all the concerts that are open to the public. If tickets are required, Culture Path can help you with ticket information.

# Accommodation

If the tour committee and director approve, hotel locations can be given out in advance of the tour and non-registered friends and family can make their own booking subject to availability.

# Bussing

Non-registered friends and family cannot ride on the group designated buses. This is primarily due to insurance regulations including the need to submit a name list of registered participants to the bus company.

# Meals

Meals are arranged under a group reservation for the registered participants. Restaurants need to plan their groceries and staffing in advance when dealing with large group bookings. If the restaurant remains open to the public and subject to the approval of the ensemble tour committee, people can inquire with restaurants about making their own reservations and would order and pay for their meal separate from the group booking.

# Sightseeing and shopping excursions

Non-registered guests can make their own arrangements to purchase tickets to attractions that are open to the public. Reminder that students must stay with their chaperone group unless they have permission from the director in advance of the tour.

# Private events, receptions, ceilidhs, etc

Primarily for insurance reasons, non-registered participants cannot attend private events. At the discretion of the tour committee and director, some events may be ticketed and will require your registration and payment in advance.

We hope that this information will help you make arrangements to get the most out of your holiday excursion and enjoy the exciting experiences on your child's tour.
