OBTAINING A U.S. PASSPORT

U.S. DEPARTMENT OF STATE

If you need a passport, visit travel.state.gov for information on how to obtain one.

Passports must be obtained & copied in color to turn into T&E by our APRIL 3 meeting.



PASSPORTS

Students will hold onto their passports using a lanyard worn their neck until we arrive in France. They will not remove it.

Chaperones will collect all passports and keep them locked up until it's time to go home.



PASSPORTS

If you already have a passport and have not done so yet, please check the expiration date.

Children under the age of 16 only have a 5-year passport.

Children 16+ have a 10-year passport.

PASSPORTS

It is a <u>U.S. REGULATION</u> that your passport <u>NOT</u> expire within 6 months of the departure or return of the trip.

THEREFORE:

If your passport expires between January 2023 - 2024, you will need to apply for a renewal ASAP.

PASSPORT REQUIREMENTS

You Must Apply in Person If:

- You are applying for your first U.S. passport
- You are under age 16
- Your previous U.S. passport was issued when you were under age 16
- Your previous U.S. passport was lost, stolen, or damaged
- Your previous U.S. passport was issued more than 15 years ago
- Your name has changed since your U.S. passport was issued and you are unable to legally document your name change



PASSPORT PROCEDURES

- Fill Out Form DS-11: *Application For A U.S. Passport* **need Social Security number **online or by hand
- Submit Completed Form DS-11
 *in Person.

- 3. Submit Evidence of U.S. Citizenship
 *birth certificate
- 4. Present Identification
- Submit a Photocopy of the Identification Document(s) Presented (Step 4)
- 6. Pay the Applicable Fee
 *minors \$95 + (\$35 fees)= \$130
- 7. Provide One Passport Photo *Rite Aid, CVS, etc.

NAME & EMAIL



• Be sure your name is entered in the T&E portal EXACTLY as it appears on your Passport.

- PARENTS: if you are NOT receiving emails from Mr. Palmer, please let me know ASAP, as email is our ONLY method of communication.
- STUDENTS: Be sure to tell your parents each time you receive an email as well.

TRANSFER BUS & TIPS



- Leaving from CB SOUTH
- Each student pays approximately \$70-\$100 for bus to/from airport (MPP).
- Tip money \rightarrow \$50-\$100 cash.
- Parents pick students up at SOUTH upon return.
- Bus & tip money will be collected at the APRIL 3 meeting.
