Dear Parents,

I am pleased to report that Pine Run will “kick-off” your child’s sixth grade year with a very unique experience. On **Thursday, September 7th and Friday, September 8th** all Pine Run sixth grade students will participate in “The Adventures in Education Program” in Warrington, Pennsylvania. This program supports one of our primary goals at Pine Run - to challenge our students to work towards excellence, not only in academics, but together as a community of learners.

Adventures in Education is an outdoors experience designed to build teamwork and cooperation among students. Over the course of two days, each sixth-grade student will participate in a high and low ropes course. The low ropes course uses team building models and a series of structured problem-solving activities to promote positive behavior, self-esteem and life skills development. All activities use the concepts of challenge and adventure to motivate and stimulate the participants’ willingness and enthusiasm for change. The high ropes course encourages students to reach beyond perceived limits, set and reach higher goals, improve confidence and self-esteem and develop trust in others. Trained staff members run ALL events; **caution and safety are of paramount importance during each activity.**

We believe students will remember this trip as a highlight of sixth grade. It is offered early in the school year because it is designed to support and improve the qualities stressed by our sixth-grade team:

Teamwork and cooperation	Trust and independence
Decision-making skills	Conflict resolution
Problem-solving abilities	Self-esteem and confidence
Willingness to take risks	Leadership skills

A student’s cost for this two-day experience is ***approximately \$84.00***. This fee covers the camp and the cost of transportation to this facility. If this cost poses an undue financial burden on your family, please advise our school counselor, Liz Heim. In the fall you will receive additional information regarding how children should dress and what to pack for the experience. **This is not an overnight experience. On Thursday, September 7th, students will depart early from Pine Run and return to Pine Run for their regular means of transportation. On Friday, September 8th, students will depart early from Pine Run and will need to be picked up from Elbow Lane at 3:00pm. Carpooling is encouraged.**

Each school year is a time of new beginnings, and this experience will set the foundation for a challenging, productive, and positive school year.

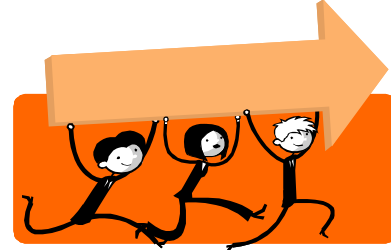

Checklist:



- ☐ Parents must complete a **Liability Waiver** and turn it into their child's homeroom teacher by **September 5th, the first day of the 23-24 school year.** *Please be certain to include an emergency contact number.*
- ☐ Parents must complete a **Pine Run Elementary School Permission Slip** and turn it into their child's homeroom teacher by **September 5th, the first day of the 23-24 school year.**
- ☐ \$42.00 payment on My Payments Plus by **June 30th.** (*My Payments Plus directions are attached*)
- ☐ \$42.00 payment on My Payments Plus by **August 25th.**

On Thursday, September 7th, students will depart early from Pine Run and return to Pine Run for their regular means of transportation. On Friday, September 8th, students will depart early from Pine Run and will need to be picked up from Elbow Lane at 3:00pm. Carpooling is encouraged.

What Students Should Bring:

1. Dress for outdoor activities: shorts or jeans, hats, sunscreen, sneakers or hiking boots, rain jacket, and sweatshirt. No open toed shoes please. We will be going rain or shine. We are told that many students under-dress for this event, so layering clothing is recommended.
2. Brown bag lunches and snacks are required. No glass bottles please. Everything must be disposable.
3. Plastic water bottles are encouraged. Please write your child's name on the bottle. Water will be provided for refills. It is recommended that drinks containing sugar/soda be left at home. The ropes course facilitators will request that all students drink plenty of water during their ropes experience.
