

# 9 REGION PROPOSALS CREATION PROCESS

- I reviewed the proposal submitted by former school board director Tracy Suits in November 2022.
- The original proposal for 9 regions did not fall within the statutory guidelines of a deviation
- Ms. Suits adjustments to regions I and 2 were reasonably close in population, so I kept those the same
- Region 4 had too high of a population, and region 9 was too low, and required changing to fall within the guidelines



## Points of Interest for each proposal:

#### **PROPOSAL A**

- 7 precincts will move
- All school directors remain in current voting region

#### PROPOSAL B

- 9 precincts move
- Board Directors
   Pepper and Lisa
   would be in the
   same region
   (Note: Mr. Pepper
   has publicly
   stated he will not
   run again)

#### **BOTH**

- Within statutory guideline of deviation
- Changes do not disrupt voting year
- Ensures directors are spread out amongst various townships and municipalities
- The population for each region is less than 14,000 residents, making each school director responsible and accessible to their constituents.
- Keeps community feel/spirit.
- All school directors remain in current voting region
- Equitable and Diverse Representation

#### Distinction from 3 Region Proposals

- Taxation without representation Disenfranchising municipalities that pay more school tax (Buckingham)
- Knocking doors currently voters have a decent chance of speaking to their board director at some point throughout the campaign process
- 9 regions for 9 municipalities
- CB has always been 9 regions the tradeoff of voting more frequently
  does not outweigh the disadvantages and disenfranchisement of voters (a
  feeling of having no power or opportunities, or of not being represented in
  the political system)
- Creating a financial barrier to running for school board keeping lower income candidates out of running.
- Restricts the ability for voters to petition for change on future maps by creating a higher threshold of signatures. (25% of 5,322 is 1,331.x3=3,993)
