1 handheld sharpener

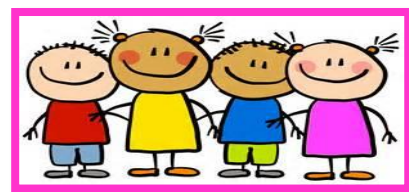
5 two-pocket folders in the following
