#### Scratch the Surface: First Impressions

What does the text say?

- Ask & Answer Questions
- Retell
- Describe Story Elements (Characters, Setting, Problem, Plot, Solution)

What is the text about? What are the main ideas? Who are the characters?

What is the author's purpose?

What is the problem? What questions do you have?

Can you summarize the text?
