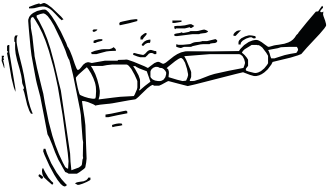


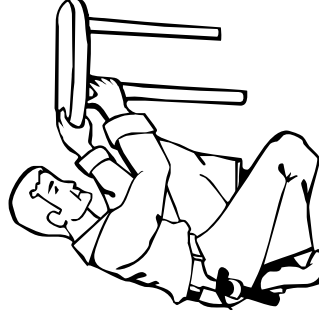
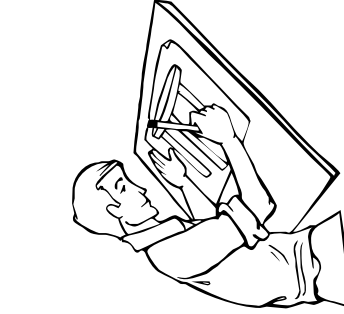
2. The Articles of Confederation created a government as weak/unsteady as a stool with one leg.
