General Supplies for ALL Third Grade Students

Please label your child's name/initials on everything (even pencils) so that we can help the children manage their supplies! A super fine tip Sharpie is great for this.

- 24 (or more) regular #2 pencils (NO mechanical or push-up pencils please)
- 1 container Lysol/Clorox/etc. antibacterial wipes
- 1 large pencil case/bag with a zipper for desk (no boxes please)
- 4 large glue sticks (FYI...Elmer's brand seems to hold best)
- 1 ultra fine and 1 fine tip BLACK Sharpie marker
- 1 set of colored pencils
- 1 yellow highlighter
- 1 family sized box of tissues (additional boxes are greatly appreciated)
- 2 sets of Expo2 Dry Erase markers (Expo 2 are **low odor** markers) and an eraser.
- 4 pocket folders
- 1 Vinyl/Plastic pocket folder for homework
- Scissors
- Headphones or ear buds to use with computers
- 5 red ball point pens
- 1 marble composition book
- A 3-pack of post-its (3"x 3")

We may be asking for additional supplies at the middle of the year to help replenish some of the supplies that have diminished or those that need to be replaced.
