Remember:

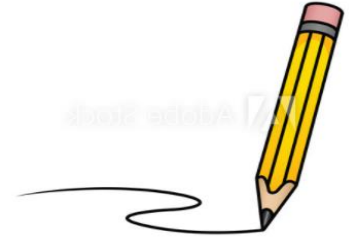
- ✓ Include a **heading** at the top of the page

- ✓ Create a **complete and meaningful sentence**.
- ✓ Begin your sentence with a **capital letter**
- ✓ End each sentence with a **punctuation mark (. ! ?)**
- ✓ Underline the spelling word used in each sentence
- ✓ Use your **best handwriting**

*Students are encouraged to use misspelled pretest words in their sentences to reinforce and practice those words.

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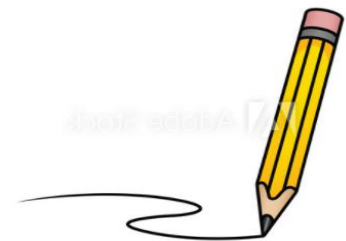
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
