



Leap into Summer Reading!

Dear Parents,

Research has shown that children who read at home over the summer do better in school in September than those who do not! In order to encourage at home reading, Bridge Valley Elementary is sponsoring a summer reading incentive. Our theme for this summer will be ***“Leap into Summer Reading.”*** We are asking each Bridge Valley student to read a minimum of six books this summer and to bring back his or her bookmark log in September. Six students that have the highest number of books read will receive a special lunch with Mr. Cochran.

Attached to this letter is a bookmark for students to record books they read over the summer. Keep everything in a safe place. If students read more than six books, they may record additional titles on the back of the bookmark or on a separate piece of paper. When school resumes in the fall, students should return their bookmark logs to their new classroom teacher the first week of school.
