The Titus Library can't wait to see what you've created!



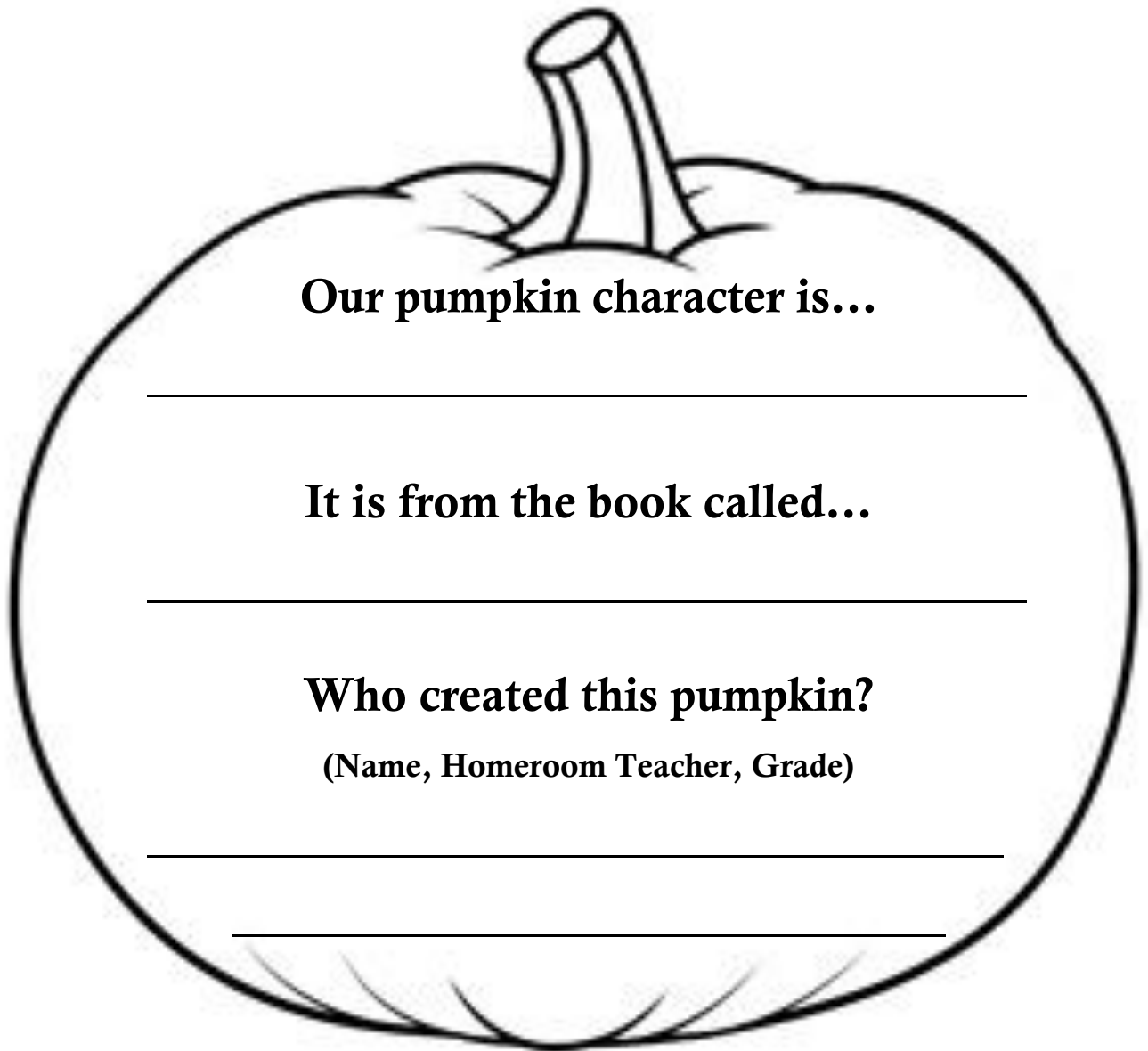
