REGULAR SCHOOL BOARD MEETING CENTRAL BUCKS SCHOOL DISTRICT

The Central Bucks Board of School Directors held its meeting on Tuesday, September 10, 2013 in the Board Room of the Educational Services Center with Vice President Paul Faulkner presiding. PUBLIC COMMENT

Andrew O'Chadlick commented on statements he read in The Intelligencer made by a faculty member about Dr. Green. He feels the statements should be looked in to. If the statements are true, then further investigation is necessary. If the statements are false, the faculty member should be fired. Mr. O'Chadlick commented he also read that one reason Dr. Green was let go was due to educational differences with the District. He then spoke about verbiage written in the Parent Handbook from the 90s and also letters written by two former teachers on student behavior in the 90s that appeared in The Intelligencer.

SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

What We Accomplished This Summer

Dr. Weitzel reviewed the 2013 summer accomplishments. Approximately 2175 students participated in CBSD summer education programs and 140 students attended MBIT Summer School. Some highlights in the Business Office were processing purchases to help complete Phase 3 of the CB Each High School Renovations, restructuring athletic accounting systems to comply with new state mandates for Title IX reporting, and continuing to analyze commercial real estate properties for potential appeal of taxable assessed values. The Human Resources Department was busy preparing RFP for new Health Care Consortium medical plans, continuing negotiations for new RX contract, and negotiating lower dental rates. The IT Department replaced desktops/laptops, reimaged older laptops for improved performance, and installed additional networking, infrastructure, and administrative software updates/upgrades. The

Operations Department worked on renovations at CB East, Holicong, Unami, Pine Run and performed annual summer cleaning, preventative maintenance, painting and grounds projects throughout the district. The Student Services Department finalized the antibullying/cyberbullying program, developed two high school electives for students with special needs and developed a comprehensive system for assessing writing skills K-6. Also, this is the first year the District ran the entire Extended School Year program. Over 200 students attended classes at CB West and Mill Creek. The Staff Developers provided a variety of workshops for professional staff over the summer such as: Common Core Overview, Introduction to Educator Effectiveness, Research-Based Instructional Strategies that Impact Student Achievement, Support Strategies for Students with Challenging Behaviors, SmartNotebook, and Schoolwires.

PA Core Standards

Dr. Weitzel, Richard Kratz, Paul Beltz, and Alyssa Walloff reviewed the PA Core Standards and the instructional shifts required in order for students to meet these standards. The standards establish what students need to learn, but they do not dictate how teachers should teach. Districts continue to develop courses of study and curriculum at the local level. Districts continue to provide staff development for teachers. Teachers continue to devise lesson plans and tailor instruction to the individual needs of the students in CB classrooms. Teachers continue to use teacher and district assessments as part of daily instruction.

Statewide assessments continue to be developed by the same company that created the PSSA and Keystone Exams. Pennsylvania has not adopted the national assessments.

The Central Bucks School District's work with Dr. Willard Daggett's Rigor and Relevance Framework for instruction and Wiggins and McTighe's Understanding by Design Model for curriculum design have provided teachers with a solid foundation for the increased rigor of the PA Core Standards. In addition, the district's focus on teaching reading in all disciplines since 2007 has laid the groundwork for the nonfiction reading and increased text complexity requirements that are an integral part of the PA Core Standards. Although Central Bucks has a solid foundation, we are in a continuous cycle of improvement – a cycle that includes a solid focus on teaching and learning and a commitment to communication among all stakeholders.
