- Questions: Write out key questions that are answered in your notes. Place these questions and points next to where you would find the answer in your notes.
- Visuals: Fill additional space with any illustrations, charts, or diagrams that add further detail or explanation.
- Recite: Cover the note-taking column with a sheet of paper. Then, looking at the questions or cue-words in the question and cue column only, say aloud, in your own words, the answers to the questions, facts, or ideas indicated by the cue-words.

Try to use every bit of space!

Name of Section

- Notes: Outline the main points from the text in your own words.
- Headings: Divide up your notes according to the headings/ subheadings used in the textbook.
- Vocab: Define important terms
- **Explain:** Providing <u>support</u> and <u>examples</u> from the textbook to explain concepts.

- **Summarize:** Write a brief summary.
- Extend: Write a question that you still have on this topic or something you just don't fully understand yet.
