Dear Groveland Elementary School Community,

We hope you are enjoying these last weeks of summer. Today, we held the first of three days of welcome back activities and professional development programming for teachers before we welcome all staff and students back next week. We are looking forward to a great school year.

Before our buildings are filled again, we wanted to provide another update on testing being conducted on the well that supplies water to Groveland Elementary School. You can read the last update from July 19 [here](#).

Earlier this month, the district received the results of third-quarter testing conducted on the well water. The well water was also tested in February and April. Like these earlier results, the third-quarter results indicated all levels are below the limits set by Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection (DEP). Another test will be conducted in the fourth quarter.

The district will continue to keep you updated as this process continues. Similar email updates were also sent to the four other schools that receive their water from wells (CB East, Holicong, Tohickon and Gayman).

We look forward to an exciting and successful start to the school year.
