Campus does not support Campus Food Service running on Macintosh-based terminals at this time. All terminals must be PC based.

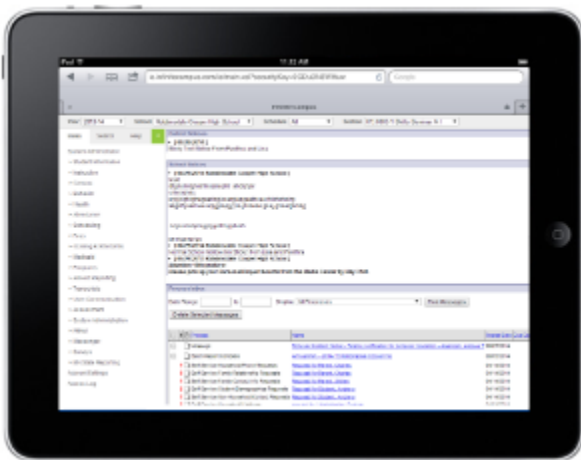
