- Dr. Yanni discussed Grade Realignment that will begin with the 2026-2027 school year. Once implemented, elementary schools will house grades K-5, middle schools will house grades 6-8, and high schools will house grades 9-12.
- Dr. Yanni discussed pioneering the full-day kindergarten program at selected schools in September 2025. The selected schools will be announced early next month.
