iRun4Life



You can help keep our gardens beautiful at Cold Spring. Watch out for a sign up for weeding days during the summer.




Fundraising Update

The HSA is a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization that funds the activities we support at our school through a variety of fundraising events and initiatives. The 2021/22 school year was a busy year for fundraising as we worked towards our goal to raise funds over the next two years to build our very own multi purpose outdoor classroom at Cold Spring.

Our calendar included a mix of events, which kicked off with a fun run and leadership program in partnership with Apex Leadership, our annual Bingo and Spring Fair events plus many other smaller fundraisers. All funds raised went directly towards supporting HSA funded activities and initiatives at our school, with surplus funds for the year going into our Outdoor Classroom fund.

We are so thrilled that at the end of the 2021/22 school year, we are in a position to make a deposit payment of almost \$60,000 to start this project. Planning and permits will begin in the fall, and work will hopefully be scheduled to commence over the summer of 2023. Reaching this goal has taken a tremendous effort on the part of the HSA along with the support of Mr. Finger, teachers and our families.

The graphic below shows a breakdown of the events and fundraisers, and how each of them contributed to the achievement of this goal.





OUTDOOR CLASSROOM



Our goal for our Outdoor Classroom was to raise \$50,000 over two years in order to start the project. We are fortunate to have been able to achieve this in one year.

A portion of proceeds from all fundraisers will go towards the fund for the outdoor classroom but a portion will also go towards the operating costs of the HSA and funding the activities we support.
