CLASSROOM MANAGEMENT	
	Timers to pace classroom activities
	Random group generators to pair students
	Random selectors to call on a variety of students
	Customized toolbars to allow for effective access and ease of use
ENGAGING STUDENTS IN LEARNING	
	Use a range of colors with pen and highlighter tools
	Annotate images, documents and web sites
	Utilize shape and text recognition tools
	Magnify and zoom in and out of content
	Add videos, podcasts and multimedia when appropriate
	Allow students to drag, write and move objects during the lesson
	Use a variety of background colors to enrich the content
	Layer objects to hide and reveal content during the lesson
VISUAL REPRESENTATIONS	
	Create moveable timelines for sequencing
	Use models, diagrams and charts throughout the lesson
	Snip images and diagrams from online resources and allow your students to interact with them
	Create Venn Diagrams or charts to compare and classify items
	Become knowledgeable of the gallery and the pre-made content
	Integrate the document camera to annotate student work
PRE/POST-LESSON RESOURCES	
	Post terms or concepts prior to a unit to build background for students
	Create screencast videos of key concepts taught in class
	Export IWB files to create PDF's of notes to post on teacher web sites
	Share lessons with colleagues that teach the same course
