Rotary Four-Way Test Essay Contest:

- This is a wonderful opportunity. *We would love for you all to participate!*
- Last year's winner, **Liam Price**, shared his experience:
 - The contest is first held at school
 - He only competed against two people, so everyone got to move on to Regionals (virtually) as the top three can move on
 - Was offered **free public speech coaching** (feedback, tips); great experience
 - Judges follow a rubric to see whether the speech incorporates the four-way test
 - Example: his speech was about homelessness in his eyes while working in a homeless shelter in California
 - Allowed to have notes (only for school and regional competition)
 - Almost like an inspirational speech, but instead explaining how to do good in the world
 - Prompt besides 4- Way Test: explain an ethical problem or issue with the four-way test; personal experience where your decision



making was influenced by the four way test OR a world issue (such as immigration)

- Can weave in both prompts
- Same prompt this year
- His first essay didn't meet all of the components of the four-way test, but the coach was able to help him
- Good for connections and resume= good experience overall
- District Winner receives \$1250 cash award (including regional award of \$150)
- Six regional winners will each receive a cash prize of \$150
 - Pearl S. Buck Youth Leadership Camp
- **What to know for now:**
 - 500- 1000 words, same prompt as last year
