### **Research Reminders:**

- Do not use Wikipedia, blogs, or someone else's research paper about a topic.
- Find REPUTABLE news sources – newspapers, magazines, global organizations.
- You may not find what you need on the first try. You have to look, look, and look some more. Looking for and finding information is half of the battle of a research based project.
- You may need to piece together small bits of information from multiple sources to create your full picture.
- Remember to note where you have found your information in order to cite the source.
