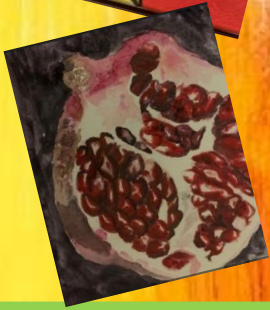


Drawing and Painting

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Exploring Drawing & Painting – 9th Grade Elective

This course is open to all students who enjoy two-dimensional work. Emphasis is placed upon developing basic drawing and painting skills and techniques. A variety of media will be used. The fundamentals of composition as found in the elements and principles of design will be used when drawing and painting from life and imagination, using realistic and abstract themes

Producing with Craftsmanship and Neatness:

- ✓ Control with materials and intentional marks

Creative Process Practiced

- ✓ Use planning and problem solving
- ✓ Create sketches, rough drafts, final projects

Creating with Visual Impact:

- ✓ Apply skill and technique for quality
- ✓ Be resourceful and unique

Responding

- ✓ Reflect and respond to artwork
- ✓ Apply feedback to all projects

Materials

- Students **MUST** bring a *pencil* and *laptop* to every class
- **Recommended:** drawing pencils, colored pencils, small paint brushes, watercolor paints

Effective Studio Habits:

- ✓ Maintains focus on project work (Time management)
- ✓ Responds to constructive criticism (Listens and tries to apply suggestions)
- ✓ Adjusts when problems occur (Patient and persistent)
- ✓ Shows willingness to spend the time needed to do GREAT work
- ✓ Remember art is about the process not just the end product
- ✓ Participates in set up and clean up
