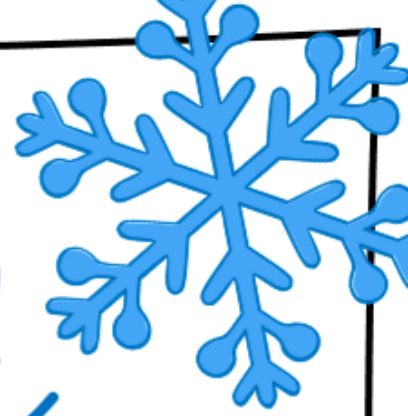

OUR LEARNING SNAPSHOT:

READING:

This week in Reading Horizons, we will practice adding suffixes to Phonetic Skill #5 words, as well as learn the sounds of -gn, -igh, and -ight. In myView, we will read a legend titled, "The Legend of the Lady Slipper." We will practice making connections to the legend, as well as learn about author's purpose.

MATH:

We are continuing to use our bar model strategy to help us visualize story problems. This week, we are exploring comparison bar models and two-step story problems. We continue to practice our addition and subtraction strategies, too. We will begin to wrap up the unit by the end of the week. The goal is to work on our in-class study guide on Friday. Because bar models are a relatively new strategy for most adults, your greatest support in studying can come from helping with the addition and subtraction computation!

WRITING:

Our Animal List Articles are wrapping up and they look so nice! We can't wait to share them with you! Later this week, we will begin our next unit, Poetry. We will begin by exploring poems and noticing some of the common features of poetry - rhyme, rhythm, syllable patterns, etc.

SOCIAL STUDIES:
