

# LE LOTO

**General Directions :** Fill in each LOTO “card” in INK (pen or highlighter) with numbers written in digits, in the range provided. Practice saying the numbers in French. When we play, mark each box with a small symbol (such as a dot or X in one of the four corners) so that we can use each card for more than one game. When you have filled in a complete row (horizontally, vertically, or diagonally) or have filled in the four corners (for the big cards on the back you also need to fill the center space to have a total of five boxes marked off), call “**LOTO!!!!**” In order to win your prize, you will need to read back to the class, in a loud voice, and in French, **all** of the numbers that you marked off. This also gives your classmates a chance to mark off any numbers that they might have missed the first time around.

**A : fill in with numbers [written in digits] from 0-10**

**B : fill in with numbers in [digits] from 11-20**



**C : fill in with numbers [in digits] from 0-20**

**D: fill in with numbers [in digits] from 10-30**



**(Remember that, for these two big cards, if you are doing the four corners, then you also need to get the center space in order to call out “LOTO!”)**

**E : fill in with numbers [written in digits] from 21-69**


**F : fill in with numbers [written in digits] from 60-101**
