Résumé: Grammaire 1

Regular -re verbs follow a fixed pattern.

attendre			
j'	attends	nous	attendons
tu	attends	vous	attendez
il/elle/on	attend	ils/elles	attendent

Verbs ending in -ger and -cer have a spelling change in the **nous** form: **nous mangeons** and **nous commençons**. The verb **commencer** + à + **infinitive** means *to start to do something*.

Ma sœur **commence** à **étudier** à 6h le soir.

To say that you do something **regularly on a certain day of the week**, use **le** before the day of the week.

To say that you are doing something **on one particular day of the week**, don't use the article in front of the day.

Résumé: Grammaire 2

The verbs **préférer** and **acheter** have spelling changes in all forms except the **nous** and **vous** forms.

Tu **préfères** nager à la piscine?

You can use colors and other adjectives as nouns to avoid repetition. Use the appropriate article **le, la, l',** or **les** in front of the adjective.

J'adore **la chemise** verte mais j'aime bien **la bleue** aussi.

Remember these rules with numbers:

- **Quatre-vingts** and multiples of **cent (deux cents)** have an -s unless they are followed by another number (**deux cent trois**).
- The number **un** changes to **une** when followed by a feminine noun (**trente et une calculatrices**).



Lettres et sons

The nasal sound [ã]

This sound is called a nasal because you make it by passing the air through the **back** of your mouth and nose. The nasal sound [ã] has four possible spellings: **an, am, en, and em**. These letter combinations don't represent a nasal sound if another vowel follows the **n** or **m**, or if the **n** or **m** is doubled. You have to learn the pronunciation when you learn the word.
