Résumé: Grammaire 1

To talk about *part of* or *some of* an item, use the partitive articles **du**, **de la** or **des**. To talk about whole items, use **un**, **une**, or **des**.

—Tu veux faire **un** gâteau?

—Oui, alors je vais acheter **de la** farine, **du** sucre et **de l'**huile.

Use pronoun **y** to replace phrases beginning with **à**, **dans**, **en**, **sur**, and **chez**.

Tu peux aller **au marché**? Oui, j'**y** vais tout de suite.

To ask questions, use **est-ce que**, inversion, or a question word.

Est-ce que tu aimes les abricots? **Est-elle** à la crêmerie?

Comment est la quiche?

Grammaire 2

Résumé: Grammaire 2

The pronoun **en** replaces **de + noun**.

—Tu veux **du fromage**? —Non, merci, je n'**en** veux pas.

When replacing nouns that follow an expression of quantity, you still use the expression of quantity with **en**.

—Tu manges **beaucoup de légumes**?

—Oui, j'**en** mange **beaucoup**.

When you use both direct and indirect object pronouns together, they follow a certain order. **Y** and **en** always come last.

Cette pomme? Tiens, je **te la** donne.

Remember that **à + le** contracts to form **au** and **à + les** contracts to form **aux**. **De + le** contracts to form **du** and **de + les** contracts to form **des**.



Lettres et sons

"h" aspiré

You've learned that you don't pronounce the letter **h** in French, like in the word **l'hiver**. However, some words begin with an *aspirated h*, or **h aspiré**. This means that you don't make a liaison with the word that comes before. For example: **les haricots**, **le héros**, **le hockey**. Since these words begin with **h aspiré**, you do not drop the **e** from the article **le**.
