THE INDUCTEE

Definition

- All individuals who have earned certification June 1, 1987 or after and who have not successfully completed a Teacher Induction Program.
- Individuals new to Central Bucks who have had professional experience outside the district.
- Individuals returning to Central Bucks following an extended period of absence.

Full Inductees are individuals who have earned certification June 1, 1987 or after and who have not successfully completed a Teacher Induction Program by law.

Partial Inductees are individuals new and returning to Central Bucks who have received a certificate before June 1, 1987.

- The Building Induction Team will determine the type and degree of activities appropriate for participation in the Induction Program on a case-by-case basis.
- Partial Inductees are assigned to the building mentor.

Responsibilities of Inductees

- To participate in the District and Building Level Induction Program.
- To maintain open lines of communication with the mentor and the building level Induction Team.
- To report major concerns or needs which hinder implementation of the Induction Program to the building level team or induction coordinator.
- To make every effort to implement suggestions offered by the mentor and the building level team.
- To assist in maintenance of record keeping.
- To participate in the Teacher Induction Program Evaluation.
