This year our class will occasionally use a Blog as a way to collaborate and communicate about classroom assignments. My main goal is to foster good thinking and writing skills in a new way.

Writing student blog "posts" requires reading, increases writing and digital literacy skills while also making the student reflect more deeply on the information they are sharing. When student writing is produced for a wider audience (in this case, our class) it's common to see considerably higher levels of engagement and motivation. Students want their posts to be well written because others are reading their writing. Also, students will be required to log into the site to allow only the CB community to visit our work.
