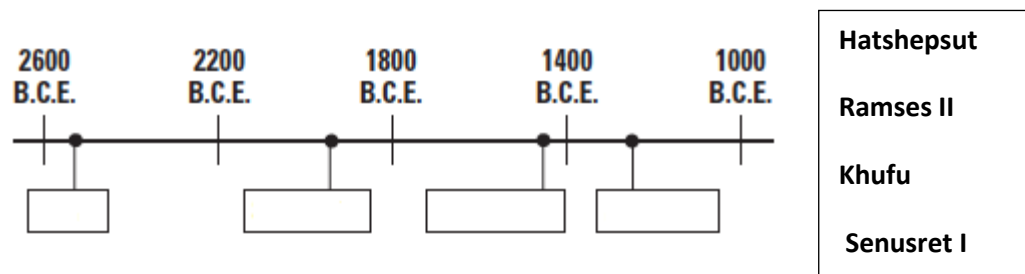


## Chapter 8 Study Guide: The Ancient Egyptian Pharaohs
