Help your child be successful by encouraging and supporting reading this summer.

Reading Tips:

1. Let your child select what books he/she wants to read. Browse the public library collection for a wide selection of books. Ask the library staff for help finding fun books to read.
2. Make reading fun! Read to and with your child. Discuss books as you share them.
3. Reading is reading! Magazines, newspapers, comics, and books all provide fun reading opportunities.
4. Encourage youngsters to try a new literary genre or subject. Try nonfiction as well as fiction. Share funny poems, a mystery, or historical fiction. Check out a book of science experiments or art projects.
5. Encourage your child to read at least 15 minutes each day.
6. Set reading goals. Very young readers are able to read or share a new book each day.
7. Make opportunities to extend learning beyond books. For example, read an insect book and visit your own backyard or a local park.

You are your child's most important teacher!

Spend time talking with your child every day, as this builds upon your child's language, vocabulary and comprehension. Read a book and talk about the story. Watch a movie and discuss the characters. Plan how the story could have ended differently. Most of all have fun. Enjoy the time you have with your child.
