Children shouldn't practice the incorrect way or become upset over a homework activity.

These may include:

- Completing a page or specific problems from the Extra Practice and Homework Book.
- A reteaching activity
- Completing an online activity (answering questions or playing a game)
- Practicing math facts
- Reviewing the "Learn" section of the workbook with your child and signing the page
- Watching a "Learn" video at home with your child
- Playing a game learned in class
