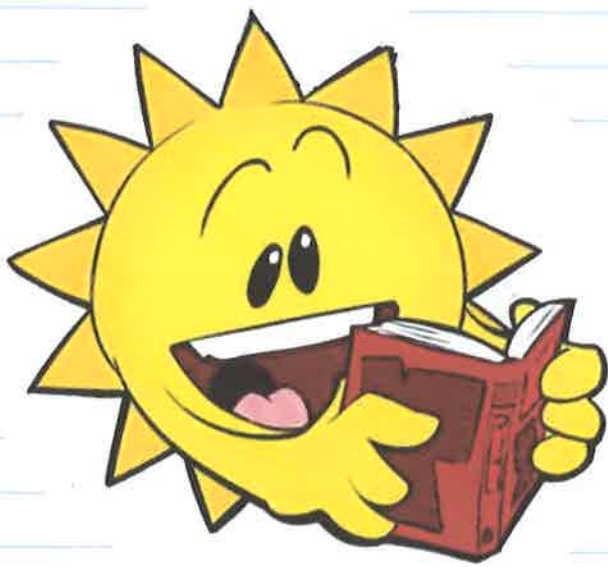


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# Before Reading...

Preview by looking at titles, subtitles, pictures, and captions.

## Activate Prior

Knowledge by thinking about what you already know.

Set a Purpose by having a reason to read.

## During Reading...

Develop Questions while reading and look for answers.

Monitor Comprehension by recognizing when you don't understand something and use "fix-up strategies" to clarify meaning.

Make Connections by looking for similarities between texts and experiences.

Vizualize by creating mental images as you read.

Infer by using details and clues to "read between the lines" and interpret meaning.

Predict by thinking about what might happen next.

Decode Words by using Phonics, word analysis, and context clues to determine the meaning of unfamiliar words and expand your vocabulary.

Determine Importance of what you read by looking for big ideas, relevant details, and bold words.

Practice Fluency by paying attention to punctuation and reading with expression.



# After Reading...

Summarize by thinking about what you've read in your own words.

Evaluate by forming an opinion about what you've read.

Synthesize by combining information you read with your own thoughts to create new ideas.
