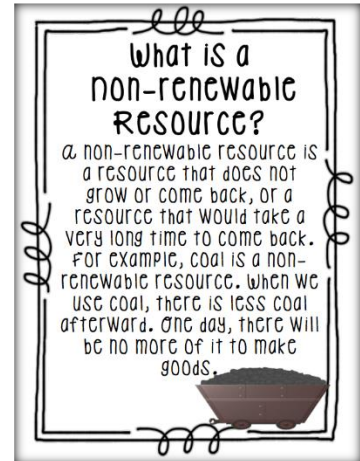
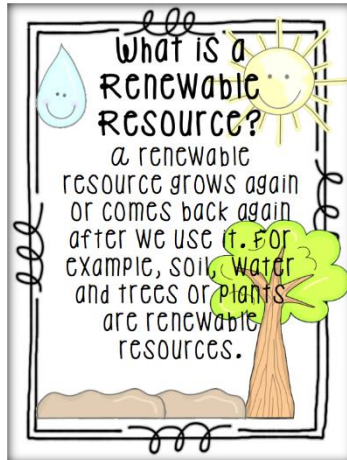
Vocabulary:

1. **Water:** A liquid that makes up oceans, rivers, lakes, etc., and falls from the clouds as rain.
2. **Environment:** Everything that surrounds a living thing.
3. **Essential:** Needed for survival.
4. **Human-made:** Produced by humans.
5. **Natural resources:** Things we use that are found in nature, such as water, air, land, forests, oil, and minerals.
6. **Resource:** Things we use that meet our needs and wants. They may be human-made or natural.
7. **Renewable Resource:** a resource that grows back or comes back again and again.
8. **Non-Renewable Resource:** a resource that does not grow back or takes a very long time to come back.

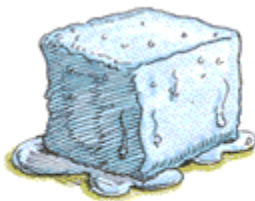

ICE

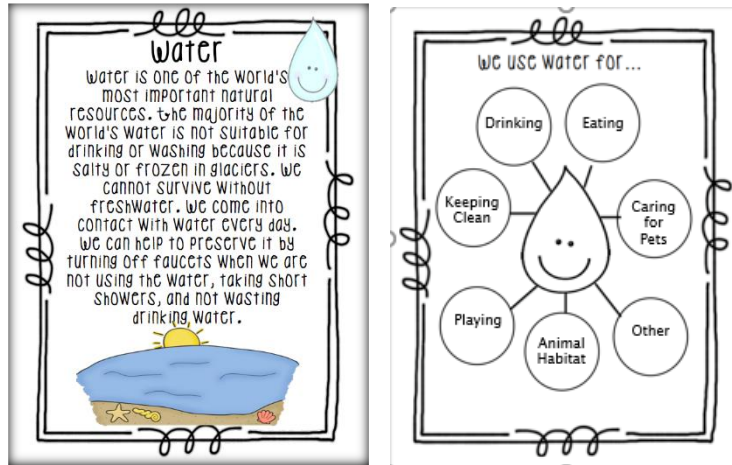


LIQUID

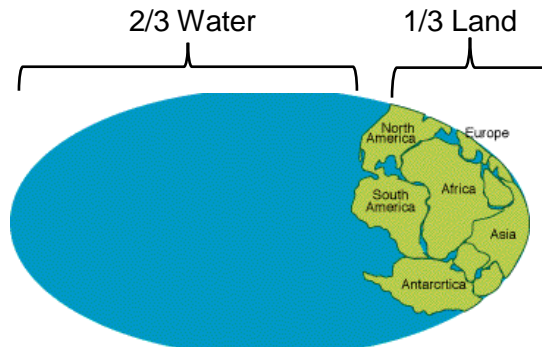

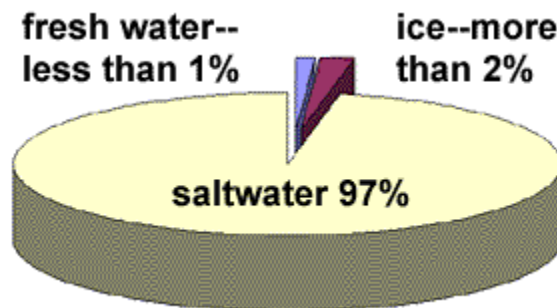
3. Humans can't survive without water. It is essential for eating, drinking, and cleaning. But most of us use much more than we actually need.



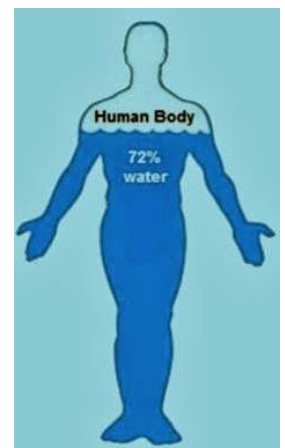
4. The water contained in the oceans, seas, polar ice caps, glaciers, rivers, streams, ponds and other forms of water make up about 2/3 of the Earth's surface.



5. Most of the earth's water (around 97%) is salty and therefore not fit for human's to drink.



6. Although you cannot tell by looking at us, humans are about 70% water.
