2. Flow Rate: How fast or slow water comes out of a faucet or shower.
3. Contaminate: To make dirty or unclean.
4. Herbicide: A chemical used to kill unwanted plants.
5. Pesticide: A chemical used to kill unwanted pests, usually insects.
6. Pollutant: Something that contaminate air, soil, or water.
7. Water Pollution: The addition of harmful substances that causes water to become unhealthy.
