Dear First Grade Families,

Hello! My name is Kelley Dougherty and I will be your child's first grade teacher this year. We'll work on becoming stronger readers and writers, increasing our skills and strategies as mathematicians, and exploring many exciting social studies and science topics such as weather and communities. I have included some helpful tips to get the year off to a smooth start as well as a list of suggested school supplies.

Here are some helpful tips for the start of first grade:

**Dismissal:** Your child received an ***"O-fish-al First Grader" name tag*** at Move-Up Day. Please attach it to his/her backpack **every day** during the first week of school to ensure a safe and smooth dismissal. You will need to provide the following information on the name tag:

- ✓ your child's first and last name
- ✓ your child's class (1-Dougherty)
- ✓ your child's dismissal procedure for each day of the week

***If your child did not attend Move-Up Day contact the main office to pick up a name tag OR email me BEFORE the first day of school so that I can complete the name tag correctly and give it to your child when he/she arrives on the first day of school. For your child's safety, I will never change his/her dismissal procedure WITHOUT written permission from you (note or email).***

**Snack:** Please send in a nutritious snack and a re-useable water bottle each day.

**Sun Safety:** Please send in a bucket hat and non-aerosol sunscreen labeled with your child's name and sealed in a plastic baggie if you choose to allow your child to apply prior to lunch/recess. Sunscreen Permission forms will be provided at Back To School Night.

**Lunch:** Eating lunch in the cafeteria is very exciting for first graders! If your child is packing a lunch, please label it with his/her first and last name and "1-DO". If your child is bringing money to purchase lunch, please place it in a small envelope labeled with his/her name and lunch choice. In the beginning of the year, I will remain with the class to assist the students with buying lunch.

# School Supply List

\*indicates that the item should be labeled with your child's name

<p>Sturdy two-pocket folders – plastic (a total of 2) ( 1-red &amp; 1- blue: <b>not</b> 3-hole punched)</p>	
<p><b>*Headphones</b> in a Ziploc bag (labeled with your child's first and last name) <b>*Please</b> make sure the plug will fit an iPad jack.</p>	
<p><b>Bucket Hat</b> or baseball cap labeled with your child's name and 1DO. (To be used during recesses to help protect your child's skin. It will be kept in a cubbie in our room.)</p>	
<p><b>Non-Aerosol Sunscreen</b> If you send sunscreen, your child will need to apply it independently. I will teach your child how to do this if you have not done so at home. Please seal sunscreen in a Ziplock bag labeled with your child's name and 1DO. (To be used before recesses to help protect your child's skin.)</p>	
<p><b>Paint Smock</b> – Any oversized shirt will do the trick. Please use a permanent marker to label it with your child's name and 1DO.</p>	
<p><b>1 Change of Clothes</b> – Please send a change of clothes including underwear and socks in case of a toileting accident and/or getting wet while playing outdoors. <i>(Put in a gallon Ziploc bag with full name on outside of bag.)</i></p>	

<p>Box of Tissues (Last Names: A-M)</p>	<p><b>Thank you for helping to keep our classroom clean and healthy!</b></p>
<p>Liquid hand soap or hand sanitizer (Last Names: L-Z)</p>	
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
